

Q & A Discussion 1: for Ward Temple and Family History Consultants – Char Mitts (facilitator)

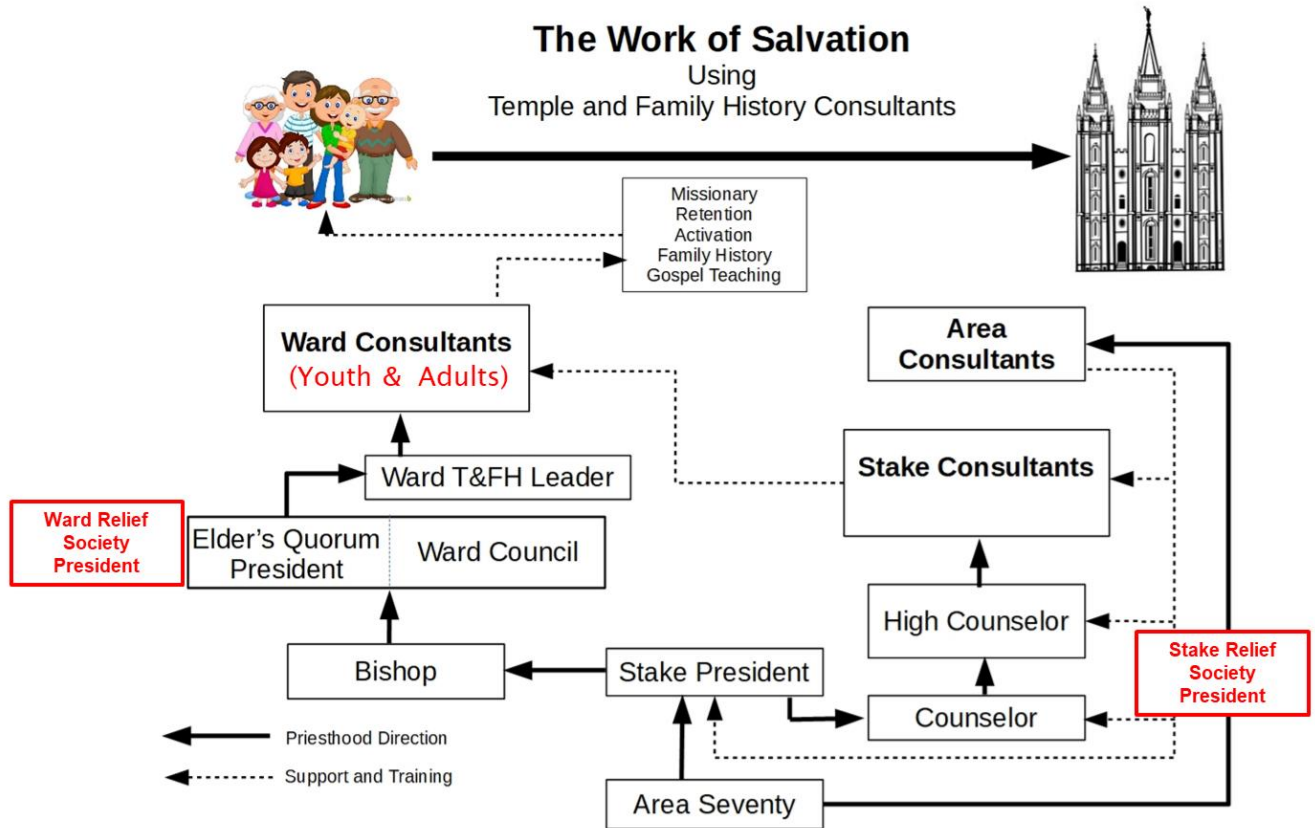
Uniting families for eternity is part of the work of salvation and exaltation. Temple and family history work is the means for uniting and sealing families for eternity.

Most of the class will be an open discussion for questions, comments and ideas to help individuals in their callings.

Outline of the class:

- ▶ Introduce those that are on the Panel – they hold callings in the wards and stakes in the area that have to do with temple and family history. There will be brief comments from the panel members.
- ▶ Briefly go over the structure of temple & family history callings in the ward and stake. Information is from The General Handbook, Section 25, pages 206-215
- ▶ The majority of the class will be an open question and discussions period. The hope is to have a positive dialog of sharing from everyone in the room, panel members and attendees.

 - What has been done and what currently is being done in your ward and/or stake having to do with temple and family history
 - Concerns and suggestions
 - What suggestion you might have for GenealogyKC that would be helpful in your calling in the future
 - Topics are open to discussion
